### Who/What:

Jazz at Lincoln Center offers the soulful and swingin' sounds of an explosive era in music with **Soul Jazz of the '60s**. Small bands like Art Blakey and the Jazz Messengers and the Cannonball Adderley and Horace Silver quintets produced some of the best-loved music of that time, combining tight ensembles with emotional solos that produced a bluesy, church-driven, down-home sound. The evening features two all-star groups led by two all-star musicians: alto saxophonist **Wess "Warmdaddy" Anderson** showcasing his inspiration by Cannonball Adderley, and drummer **Kenny Washington** channeling his hero drummer Art Blakey and master composer-pianist Horace Silver. Washington's group consists of **Nicholas Payton** (trumpet), **Grant Stewart** (saxophone), **Mike LeDonne** (piano) and **David Wong** (bass). Anderson's group consists of **Nnenna Freelon** (vocals), **Terell Stafford** (trumpet), **Benny Green** (piano), **Gerald Cannon** (bass) and **Louis Hayes** (drums).

There is a free pre-concert discussion, nightly at 7pm, hosted by Jazz at Lincoln
