Who/What:

Jazz at Lincoln Center’s **WeBop** classes for the Winter term are now open for enrollment with free trial classes for interested parents on Saturday, December 5th. WeBop’s winter term, intended for children ages 8 months—5 years old, explores the instruments that make up a jazz combo. Each week, participants move, sing and play along as they learn about each instrument, culminating in a jam session with a live jazz band. These classes offer a creative outlet for children and their parents/caregivers to explore jazz through movement, song, storytelling and play.

Classes are segmented based on age:

- HIPSTERS: 8-16 months old
- SCATTERS: Walking-23 months old
- STOMPERS: 2-3 years old
- GUMBO GROUP: 3-5 years old
- SYNCOPATORS: 4-5 years old
