In an exclusive U.S. engagement, GRAMMY® award-winning composer and guitarist **Mario Adnet** and his ensemble **Ouro Negro** perform in *Journey to Brazil* at Jazz at Lincoln Center. The virtuosic group honors the music of Brazilian composer Moacir Santos (1924-2006), whose six decades of innovative music influenced Antonio Carlos Jobim, Milton Nascimento and generations of musicians worldwide.

The group will perform a selection of Mr. Santos' best work and pieces from Adnet's *Ouro Negro* CD. Santos appeared on this CD recording that rehabilitated Santos' reputation in his own country and abroad.
