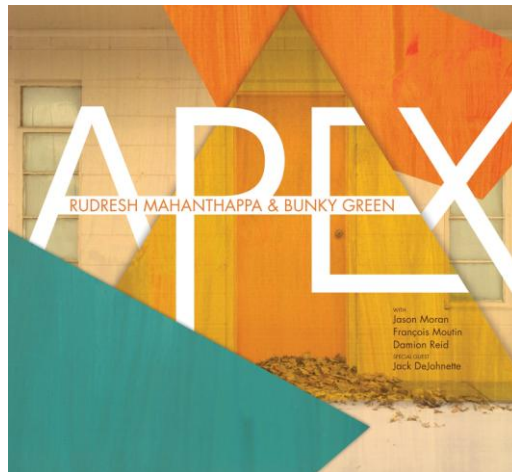

Who/What:

Jazz at Lincoln Center hosts its second Listening Party of the 2010-11 season with alto saxophonist **Rudresh Mahanthappa** as he discusses his newest release, *Apex* (Pi Recordings), with Jazz at Lincoln Center's Ken Druker. This album, being released on the day of the Listening Party, is a blazing collaboration between Mahanthappa and fellow alto saxophonist Bunky Green that puts on display a fifty-year continuum of state-of-the-art saxophone playing. Featuring an all-star band of Jason Moran on piano, François Moutin on bass, and switching off on drums, Damion Reid and Jack DeJohnette, *Apex* shines a much-deserved spotlight on Bunky Green, a hugely influential but under-recognized original in jazz.
