Who/What:

One of the most important musicians of the 20th century, Duke Ellington wrote over 1000 compositions and kept a loyal band for over 50 years. He has been called America’s greatest composer. The **Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra** with **Wynton Marsalis** explores the inimitable style and infectious swing of the man who truly deserved the name “Duke” in this interactive, hour-long concert for families. Repertoire will include classic Ellington tunes, “East St. Louis Toodleoo,” “Mood Indigo,” “C Jam Blues,” “Black and Tan Fantasy,” “Isfahan,” “Carolina Shout,” and “Chinoiserie.” Recommended for ages 6 and up.
