**Who/What:**

To celebrate great Argentinean tango master Astor Piazzolla's 90<sup>th</sup> birthday, multi-instrumentalist and jazz ambassador Paquito D'Rivera, together with music advisor Pablo Aslan, brings to Jazz at Lincoln Center an unprecedented focus on tango's relationship to jazz and on Piazzolla's central role in its development.

D'Rivera brings together the world's finest musicians who continue keeping the tango tradition alive: Pablo Ziegler, who was Piazzolla's pianist for many years until his passing, and Piazzolla's grandson, Papi Piazzolla, who arrives direct from Argentina for this concert event. Performing *The Music of Astor Piazzolla* are Paquito D'Rivera, alto sax, clarinet, music director; Pablo Aslan, contrabass, music advisor; Scott Robinson, baritone saxophone; Diego Urcola, valve trombone, trumpet; Antonio Madruga, piano; Octavio Brunetti, piano; Pablo Ziegler, piano; Papi Piazzolla, drums; Nicholas Danielson, violin; Leonardo Granados, vocals, percussion; Dave Samuels, vibraphone, marimba; Hector del Curto, bandoneon; Daniel Binelli, bandoneon; and Claudio Rigazzi, guitar.

Pre-concert discussion, featuring Paquito D'Rivera, Pablo Aslan, Papi Piazzolla and Pablo Ziegler, and hosted by Nabate Isles, is free to all ticketholders in The Agnes Varis and Karl Leichtman Studio at 7pm.
